Transport Canberra and City Services is interested in using the following Philips LED products for both V & P category roads, with the objective of offering an energy efficient lighting solution:

- 1. BVP381 100W
- BVP382 200W
- 3. BRP392 130W
- 4. BRP711 36W

To introduce these luminaires into the public street light network in the ACT, the device load for each luminaire must be included in the AEMO load table. TCCS would support the proposal for the above products to be included in the National Electricity Market Load Tables for the Unmetered Load Tables for Unmetered Connection Points in accordance with the Unmetered Load Guide.

Kindly proceed with the measurement of electrical load of these luminaires through AEMO for them to be considered for future replacement of less efficient light sources in this area. As soon as it has been load tested by AEMO and included in the AEMO load table, please inform us of the information.
