How AEMO will engage with stakeholders

What is the WA Market Reform Program?

AEMO's WA Market Reform Program (WAMRP) delivers the reforms following the Electricity Market Review (EMR).

The WAMRP will progress through three Workstreams – Retail, Wholesale and System Operations and will prepare AEMO and Market Participants for the changes that will arise as a result of the reform.

AEMO will leverage existing National Electricity Market (NEM) knowledge and technology to set up new market systems applicable for WA market specific requirements. This approach is considered be the most cost effective solution to implement the EMR reforms.

AEMO recognises that stakeholder engagement is critical for the reform program to succeed and to enable market readiness. AEMO will provide pertinent and timely information to support Market Participants in their transition to the new arrangements.

Stakeholders will be engaged through the existing WA Electricity Consultative Forum to provide high-level Market Participant oversight and guidance throughout the Program; and targeted Workstream Forums, and where required, specific, issued-based Working Groups.

How do I stay informed?

Each of the Workstreams - Retail, Wholesale, and Systems Operations, has an AEMO lead who will develop and implement a program of work including training and other support functions. The Lead will also facilitate the Workstream Forums and establishment of Working Groups when required.

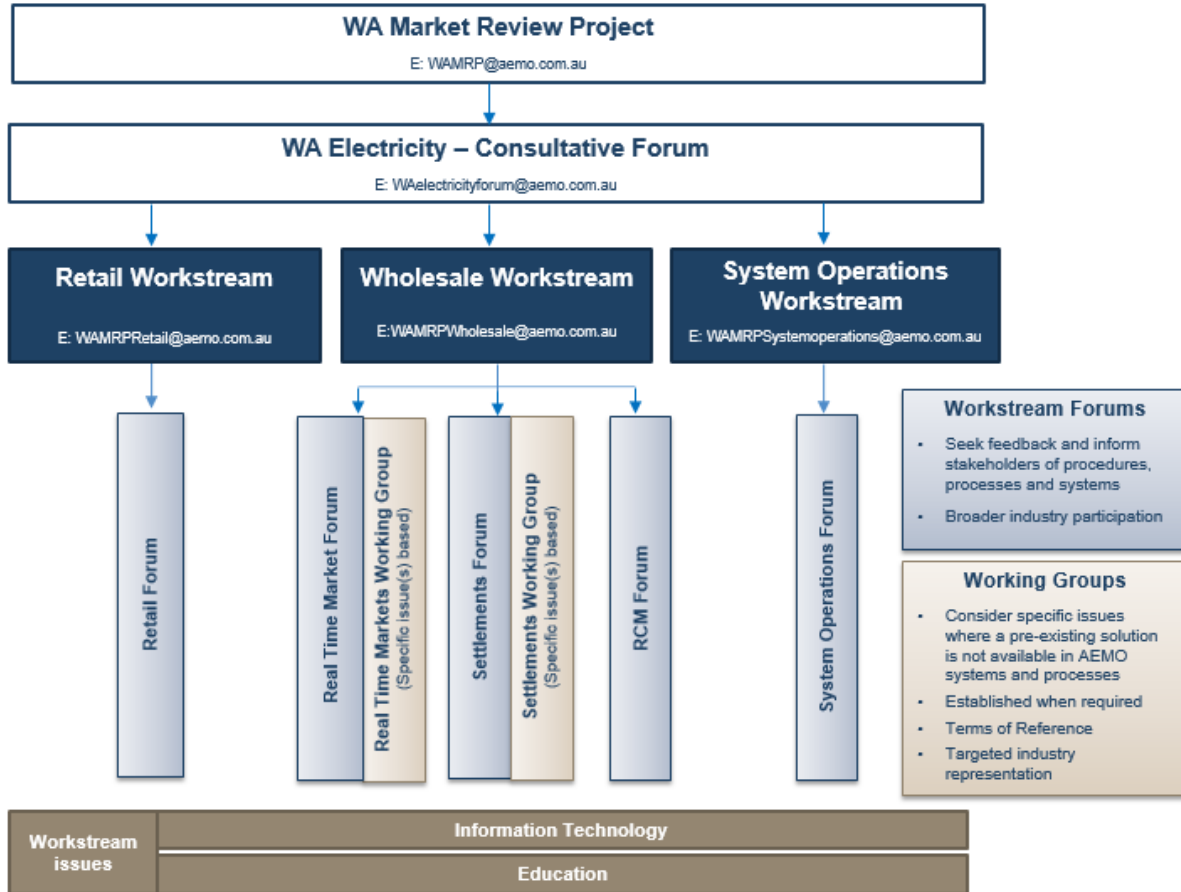
