Capacity Transfer and Auction Procedures – Contract Information

In accordance with clause 5 of the Capacity Transfer and Auction Procedures (CTAP), Contract Information must be provided to AEMO to allow the accurate identification of facility agreements for the purposes of the transaction support arrangements. Contract Information must be provided to AEMO before market participants can submit an order for trading on the Capacity Trading Platform (CTP) or a bid for the Capacity Auction (DAA). Contract Information is provided to AEMO through the submission of the Contract Details data transaction using the e-Hub API interface.

In accordance with transitional provision 27.2(c) of the CTAP, a facility operator must provide to AEMO the Contract Information for the transportation facility as soon as practicable after the facility operator is granted access to the CTP Interface and in any event no later than the date specified in a notice issued by AEMO to facility operators.

This notice informs facility operators of the facilities in the table below, that, in accordance with clause 27.2(c) of the CTAP, **Contract Information that is effective on 26 June 2019 must be provided to AEMO by 25 June 2019**.
