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1. Introduction

1.1 Overview

These are the release notes for the Generator Performance Standards (GPS) system. GPS was previously managed by Western Power through the Technical Rules, however as a part of the WEM Reforms¹ this compliance monitoring obligation has been transferred to AEMO.

The development of the new GPS System, within the existing WEMS MPI, will support Rule Participants and the Economic Regulation Authority in meeting their new obligations under the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules.

AEMO has presented the changes being deployed in this release at the following WRIG-IT sessions:

- 21 April 2021 A specific showcase was presented to Market Participants on the GPS System and functionality.
- 10 June 2021 Further information and follow up on Market Participant questions and changes to functionality.

WEMS 3.41 includes all the changes introduced in WEMS 3.40, which was required to support the Settlements Enhancements project. Please refer to the <u>WEMS Pass 1.7, WEMS 3.40 and RCM 1.21 Release Notes</u> for further details of this version.

2. GPS System Overview

The new GPS System will allow Rule Participants to undertake the following functions in the WEMS MPI:

- View and download Generator Performance Standard (GPS) Submissions
- View and download Generator Monitoring Plans (GMP)
- Report Non-Compliances for GPS or GMP
- Submit Rectification Plans for GPS or GMP
- View Progress of Non-Compliances and Rectification Plan for GPS or GMP
- Amend Approved Rectification Plans for GPS or GMP

The WEMS MPI User Guide provides users with instructions on how to perform these functions.

The functions performed using the GPS System are summarised in Table 3 by Rule Participant.

Supported GPS Submission template version

Figure 1 GPS Template version compatibility with GPS System version



4. GPS System Access

Rule Participants will be able access the GPS System through the existing WEMS MPI. The GPS System will be accessible through the WEMS MPI menu bar (see Figure 2).

As the GPS System resides within WEMS MPI, GPS System users must ensure they have an WEMS MPI account (including an RSA token) with the appropriate roles assigned.

Not Supported

Any WEMS MPI user with "Full Access" to the "User Management" role can allocate appropriate permissions to an existing WEMS MPI user.

More broadly, the Market Participant Administrator for each Rule Participant and the Economic Regulation Authority is responsible for the management of roles within their respective organisations (see MPA Guide for further information). Market Participant Administrator roles themselves and requests for RSA tokens are managed by AEMO through the Market Operations team (see section 3 of WEMS MPI User Guide for more information).

As a part of this release, a new "Generator Performance Std" role has been created within the existing user management functionality of WEMS MPI (see Figure 2). The two levels of access for this new role are:

- 1. Full Access: This enables the user to perform all functions available to the Rule Participant.
- 2. **Read Only Access**: This enables the user to be able to view and download GPS data, but is unable to perform any actions (e.g. submit, amend, add comments etc).

Please note that a WEMS MPI user who does not have either of these roles/permissions assigned will be unable to access any GPS related information through the WEMS MPI Portal.




Figure 3 Updated WEMS MPI User Rules

5. Market Trial

Important: The GPS System is access through the existing WEMS MPI, this means additional user accounts may be required for both the Market Trial and Production environments. Please refer to your Market Participant Administrator to set up the required user accounts.

Market Trial for the GPS System begins on 30 June 2021 and ends on 27 July 2021. The GPS System will be moved to Production on 28 July 2021, subject a successful trial period.
