



2 CTP Interface Changes

2.1 Landing Page

Figure 1 Submitted Commissioning Test Plan Details




The header of the landing page (Commissioning Test Plans) no longer contains an option to download the template .xls as this has been de-commissioned. To start compiling a new CTP the 'NEW CT PLAN' button launches a web-form to compile and submit both the CTP Detail and Schedule.

The icons allow the CTP Details to be viewed, edited or withdrawn.

A 'speed filter' check-box has been placed at the top of the Submitted Commissioning Test Plans section to allow only CTPs in execution on the current calendar day to be displayed.

2.2 Draft Commissioning Test Plans

Figure 2 Draft Commissioning Test Plan Details




The landing page has a second section for Draft Commissioning Test Plans. This allows new CTPs and amendments to existing CTPs to be drafted over a period of time before submission.

The icons allow the Draft CTP to be viewed, edited, deleted or, when the full CTP details and schedule have been completed, submitted to AEMO. (Draft CTPs are not visible)

2.3 Add / Edit Commissioning Test Plan Details


Figure 3 Add / Edit Commissioning Test Plan Details



All details relating to the CTP are now added on a single web-form. The CTP period must be entered first, then the user can select the required Facility.

2.4 Add / Edit Commissioning Test Plan Schedule

Figure 4 Add / Edit Commissioning Test Plan Schedule





Once the Details are added, the Schedule can be entered on the new Commissioning Test Plan Schedule web-form.

The user can add information relative to each block of Dispatch Intervals during the CTP period.

Figure 5 View Commissioning Test Plan Details






2.6 View Commissioning Test Plan Schedule

The new View Commissioning Test Plan Schedule web-form allows the schedule to be viewed for each calendar day during the CTP period.

The information can be viewed in 'condensed' format where consecutive Dispatch Intervals with the same information are grouped together or in 'expanded' format where the details for each individual Dispatch Interval are displayed.


Figure 6 View Commissioning Test Plan Schedule

The View Commissioning Test Plan Profiles web-form displays the schedule in graphical format. The user can toggle between the Active Power and Reactive Power figures for both the Preferred and Alternative schedules.
