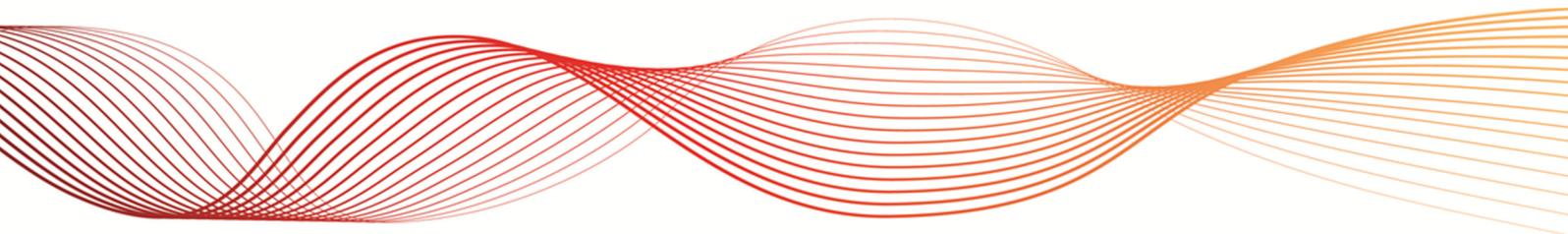

## 2. RESOLVED ISSUES

	Reference	Summary	Problem
●	WEMS-6186	Automated emails generated during the single association transfer change request workflow is being sent from the invalid email address.	Emails generated by the single association transfer change request are being sent from <code>associationtransfer@WEMS</code> which does not exist. This fix ensures emails will be sent from <a href="mailto:noreply@aemo.com.au">noreply@aemo.com.au</a> .
●	WEMS-6185	The System Management incoming/outgoing file processing is unable to handle disruptions to its workflow.	Disruptions have caused file incoming/outgoing file processing to stall in certain circumstances. Changes have been made to this process to ensure greater resilience to disruptions.
●	WEMS-6153 and WEMS-6052	In the AEMO internal Reserve Capacity Test tool, the test cycle end dates are displayed incorrectly.	The Reserve Capacity test cycle end dates are prepopulated with the delivery date instead of the trading date which trigger validation errors. This fix ensures that the end date is prepopulated correctly.
