## Declared Wholesale Gas Market in Victoria – Suspension and Deregistration Notice

This is a suspension notice issued to Weston Energy Pty Ltd (**Market Participant**) under rule 260 of the National Gas Rules (**NGR**).

As the Market Participant did not satisfy the margin call detailed below by the time set in accordance with the NGR, the Market Participant is suspended from the Victorian Declared Wholesale Gas Market from the gas day indicated below. The relevant details of this suspension are as follows:

Reason for Suspension	NGR rule 263(5) – Market Participant failure to satisfy a margin call made on 23 May 2022 by the due time of 2pm on 23 May 2022, following which AEMO must issue a suspension notice.
Registrable Capacity	Declared Wholesale Gas Market: Market Participant – Retailer
Conditions of suspension	While the suspension is in effect, the Market Participant must not: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• submit any bids or demand forecasts for the declared wholesale gas market;</li> <li>• inject gas, or tender gas for injection, into the declared transmission system;</li> <li>• withdraw gas, or tender gas for withdrawal, from the declared transmission system; or</li> <li>• deliver any transfer requests for supply points under the Retail Market Procedures (Victoria).</li> </ul>
Gas day from which the suspension will commence	24 May 2022 commencing at 0600 AEST. This is also the <b>RoLR gas day</b> for the purposes of the Retail Market Procedures (Victoria).

You have indicated that you will not meet the margin call, however, for completeness we inform you that AEMO will revoke this notice if the Market Participant:

- meets the above margin call in full before the start of the gas day on which the suspension takes effect; and
- is otherwise compliant with all prudential requirements under Part 19 of the NGR.


AEMO will publish this suspension notice as required by NGR rule 260(2).

You are also notified that AEMO has determined to revoke the Market Participant's registration (Market Participant – Retailer) effective from the date of suspension, in accordance with NGR rule 260(9).

Neither delivery of this suspension notice nor deregistration of the Market Participant waives or prevents the exercise of any of AEMO's rights, powers or remedies and AEMO reserves its rights, powers and remedies under the NGR, the National Gas Law, at law and in equity.
