

1. NOTICE OF SECOND STAGE OF CONSULTATION

National Electricity Rules – Rule 8.9

Date of Notice: 26 April 2023

1.1. Structure of Participant Fees for the Consumer Data Right (CDR) declared NEM project

This notice informs all Registered Participants and interested parties (Consulted Persons) that AEMO is commencing the second stage of its consultation on the determination of the structure of Participant fees to recover costs for the introduction and facilitation of the Consumer Data Right (CDR), and the performance of the CDR functions by AEMO. Under clause 2.11.1(be) of the National Electricity Rules (Rules), the introduction and facilitation of the CDR, requiring AEMO to carry out CDR functions, is taken to have been determined to be a declared NEM project under clause 2.11.1(ba) of the Rules (CDR declared NEM project).

This consultation is being conducted by AEMO for the purposes of clauses 2.11.1(bf) and 8.9 of the Rules and has effect only for the purposes set out in the Rules.

Invitation to Make Submissions

AEMO invites written submissions on the Draft Report and Determination (Draft Report), including any alternative or additional proposals you consider may better meet the objectives of this consultation and the national electricity objective in section 7 of the National Electricity Law.

Please identify any parts of your submission that you wish to remain confidential, and explain why. AEMO may still publish that information if it does not consider it to be confidential, but will consult with you before doing so.

Please note that material identified as confidential may be given less weight in the decision-making process than material that is published.
