1 Welcome

- Members welcomed and agenda outlined.

2 NEM Reform Program and Implementation Roadmap

- AEMO provided an overview of the NEM Reform program and NEM Reform Implementation Roadmap.
- AEMO noted that the initiatives IDX, IDAM & PC are Foundational and Strategic initiatives which
 AEMO has identified for the NEM Reform Implementation Roadmap. They are investments in legacy
 systems to deliver an uplift to base capability to enable or drive efficiency in reform implementation.

3 Initiatives Overview

 AEMO provided an introduction of the three initiatives and the proposed approach for this program of work and consultation.

3.1 Industry Data Exchange (IDX)

- AEMO provided information on the IDX initiative as outlined on slides 12- 13 of the accompanying slide pack.
- The following question was raised;

Raised By	Question	Response
Paul Greenwood – Vector Metering	In the context diagram, are we suggesting that the scope is the middle box?	In simple terms, the scope is everything between the left box and the middle box of the diagram. It deals with interfaces with participants. The notional target state is to have a consolidated or unified exchange mechanism that comes out of that middlebox. Also noting that the volume and type of participants is evolving with the energy transition and reform.

3.2 Identity and Access Management (IDAM)

 AEMO provided information on the IDAM initiative as outlined on slide 14 and 15 of the accompanying slide pack.



3.3 Portal Consolidation (PC)

- AEMO provided information on the PC initiative as outlined on slide 16 and 17 of the accompanying slide pack.
- The following questions were raised;

Raised By	Question	Response
Mark Riley - AGL	One of the things we have identified internally, is the need to facilitate formal data sharing for minor jobs or minor programs, instead of sharing information via email. There is a concern about privacy and cyber security with current practices. We want to move them into market net to improve our security on them and reduce our vulnerability.	Whether it is market net or other, we will look at an optimal secure capability for the communication of data between participants that allows you to leverage authentication to know that you're talking to the right party. The point has been noted as a very relevant consideration for the consultation.
Dino Ou - IntelliHUB	Is the intent that the business case will define the preferred option for each initiative?	I expect we will land on a recommendation within the terms of reference of this forum. We do not have decision making rights however we will be in a position to say what we think is the best way forward, and the rationale for that.

4 Industry Consultation

- AEMO presented stakeholders with an overview of the upcoming industry consultation with further information available on slide 19 and Appendix B of the accompanying slide pack.
- AEMO advised that it will stand up a business and technical focus groups for each initiative for a
 duration of four months. It was noted that the next step is a discovery session on 17 April 2023 which
 aims to workshop industry pain points and benefits for IDAM and PC.
- The session will be followed by a survey to focus group members to assess outcomes of the discovery session.
- AEMO encourages members to provide their perspective on the overall consultation approach.

Alexander Wilson - AGL	As a recommendation, each organisation should provide point of contact (one voice) for the duration of the consultation period. This will ensure communication to AEMO is consistent.	The suggestion will be taken on board.



Dino Ou - IntelliHUB	Will there be a dedicated webpage for all material associated with these initiatives	Yes
Greg Daley – CitiPower, Powercor and United Energy and Mark Riley - AGL	How will AEMO ensure adequate feedback loops in between business and technical sessions?	The workshop model has been drafted to best facilitate a balance between the desire for an efficient consultation process as expressed by RDC and allowance for sufficient engagement across business and technical working groups. Each workshop has been assessed for parallel vs sequential execution along with opportunities for out of cycle feedback to suit the compressed consultation timeline. The session 2 workshop is intended to provide much of the technical and business discovery inputs to help validate these assumptions and further shape where required the session timing and agenda.

Yvonne Tucket – Origin Energy	Is AEMO looking to obtain a high- level participants impact assessments to allow and inform the business case?	We are looking at options noting stakeholder feedback suggesting avoiding a full costing exercise.
Vishnu Vijayan – Ampol	Are the Discovery Workshops In- person and Online meetings or only In-Person?	We are looking at the format based on people's availability – likely we'll have a hybrid approach.
