

- GRCF to consider which of the following options, if applicable, an explanatory note could be inserted to describe how the meters status is populated in an MDN Transaction.
 - Option 1 provide an explanatory note only where meter status values are defined in Build Packs
 - Option 2 provide an explanatory comment only where MDN transaction is referenced in Build Packs
 - Option 3 Provide and explanatory note for both option 1 and 2
- Otherwise, GRCF to provide an alternative to the above options.
