1. Welcome and Previous meeting minutes

Dean Sharafi (AEMO) opened the meeting at 1.02 pm the minutes from the previous WAECF (4 May 2022) were endorsed. AEMO to publish the minutes as final on the [website](#) (Action Item 1.1).

2. AEMO Operational Updates

2.1. Power System Update

Jaroslav Krata (AEMO) presented a power system update discussing low frequency events and the asynchronous generating system response, using the event that took place on 26 May 2022 as an example.

2.2. Reserve Capacity update

Neetika Kapani (AEMO) provided an update on Reserve Capacity activities noting:

- The 2022 EOI summary report will be published on 30 June 2022, this report will provide an indication of how much capacity is likely to come online in the Reserve Capacity Mechanism for the 2024-25 Capacity Year. Participation in the EOI process is mandatory to apply for Certified Reserve Capacity.
- The winter Reserve Capacity testing period has commenced. The formal testing period will commence from 8 July 2022.

2.3. 2022 WEM Electricity Statement of Opportunities (ESOO) Key findings

Grace Lui (AEMO) presented the key findings from the 2022 WEM ESOO, providing detail around the 2021-22 summer peak demand, peak demand and consumption outlook, minimum demand outlook and DER forecasts.

3. AEMO's Allowable Revenue and Forecast Capital Expenditure (AR6) Update

Mike Hales (AEMO) provided an update on AEMO's Allowable Revenue and Forecast Capital Expenditure (AR6) submission noting; the ERA's final determination was published on 30 May 2022. Opex approved was 6.6% less than the revised submission, all Capex projects except WAMS were approved with reduced amounts (15%). A potential in-period submission may be required for 5MS and RCM review projects. The final determination can be found ERA's [website](#).

4.1. WEM Reform update

Andrew Smith (AEMO) presented an update on the WEM Reform Program covering June 2022, noting the overall status is still in amber because of challenges acquiring and retaining required resources in the current tight labour market.
