1 Welcome and previous meeting minutes

Martin Maticka (AEMO) opened the meeting at 1:01pm, welcomed attendees to WAGCF No. 23.

The minutes from the previous WAGCF (10 August 2023) were endorsed. AEMO to publish the minutes as final on the website (action item 1.1).

2 Updated GPG Forecast

Richard Bowmaker (RBP) presented a brief updated version of the GPG forecasts, noting the significant changes to the forecast since the last presentation made to the WA Gas Statement of Opportunities (GSOO) Forecasting Reference on 24 October.

Stakeholder discussion points

• How new and existing builds effect the forecasts and the dependency on gas supply contracts needed for potential new builds.

3 Updated gas demand forecast

Sandy Ng (AEMO) presented a comparison between the 2023 draft forecasts and the updated draft forecast, noting the 2022 low and high GPG forecasts were applied in the 2023 draft forecasts while the latest 2023 GPG forecast are applied in the 2023 updated draft forecasts.

Stakeholder discussion points



- The assumptions made around renewables offsetting the increase in gas demand due to coal retirements.
- Points of alignment in GPG forecasts between the GSOO and the Electricity Statement of Opportunities (ESOO)
- Assumptions made around new builds.
- There will be an indication for potential Hydrogen and Bio Methane for WA published in the 2023 GSOO, this will not impact the supply demand balance.

4 Draft supply forecast

Sreeparna Saha (AEMO) presented the potential gas supply forecast draft focusing on three key areas being, the forecasting approach and methodology, updated potential gas supply forecast and a comparison of this year's forecast to the 2022 WA GSOO.

Stakeholder discussion points

- Assumptions made around potentially delayed projects.
- The considerations made around production capacity and how they have fed into the forecasts.

5 WA Domestic Gas (Domgas) Policy

Vivek Karia (JTSI) provided an update on the developments around the WA Domgas policy covering a brief overview of the policy, a high look at compliance on a project level and the compliance process, the key policy challenges and opportunities and a forward to into some of the upcoming priorities.
