#### 1 Welcome

- · Alex Gillespie (Chair) opened the meeting with an acknowledgement of country.
- Stakeholders were reminded that the session is being recorded.
- Alex introduced Sandy Ng from AEMO who presented on the proposed amendments to the WEM Procedure (Procedure).

### 2 WEM Procedure: Mid Peak Electric Storage Resource Obligation Intervals

- Sandy provided the APCWG with some background on the reason for the changes.
- AEMO is amending the Procedure to align with changes to the WEM Rules. The proposed amendments:
  - reflect a new focus on Mid-Peak Electric Storage Resource Obligation Interval (MPESROI);
  - include changes to Long-Term PASA arrangements (via an amended definition for 'Peak Demand Period'), to provide for initial MPESROI values;
  - set out circumstances that allow AEMO to determine changes to previously published MPESROI; and
  - reflect updated consultation and publication requirements.



- Consultation was released on 22 May 2024 with submissions closing on 20 June 2024.

- Attendees were invited to ask questions or provide feedback. While no questions or feedback were
