

GWCF September 2023 Meeting Notes

1 Welcome and attendance / apologies – Luke Stevens, AEMO

Luke Stevens (AEMO) welcomed all to the meeting and acknowledged country. No apologies were received.

The GWCF noted AEMO's <u>Competition Law Protocol</u> and its requirements on both AEMO and participants. Luke Stevens (AEMO) noted in the chat that the meeting recording had started. The AEMO Privacy Notice was included as a footnote of the meeting agenda.

There were no objections to the agenda or previous meeting notes.

2 AEMO update – Luke Stevens, AEMO

Luke Stevens (AEMO) provided an overview of the proposed procedure changes to the Wholesale Market Procedures to account for hydrogen, Distribution Connected Facilities (DCF) and Zonal Heating Values (ZHV).

Daniel McGowan (AEMO) provided an overview of the proposed procedure changes to the Retail Market Procedures.

Questions were received as follows:

- Jennifer Brownie (Queensland Electricity Users Association) asked about when residential gas consumers would know that hydrogen can be included in the mix that arrives in their home, given that the procedure changes are to be implemented by 1 May 2024.
 - Luke Stevens (AEMO) noted that the Hydrogen Park Murray Valley is expected to go live in 2025 based on AGIG's website. There probably will be a communication process as part of that implementation by the distributor to customers within that network. AEMO will confirm with the distributors as an action item.

Note: AGIG confirmed that for the Hydrogen Park Murray Valley Project, communication to customers about receiving blended gas currently sits with distributors rather than retailers. AGIG has direct mailed each customer with a letter and other information such as pamphlets and relevant websites. AGIG will continue to undertake further engagement activities such as stalls at local events and markets to raise awareness.

- Melissa Perrow (Brickworks) asked if there will be any changes to the STTM rules given there are already injections into the Sydney STTM (Malabar biomethane, and Jemena hydrogen blending) and in the Adelaide STTM (AGIG hydrogen blending).
 - Luke Stevens (AEMO) responded that those changes are upcoming as noted in slide 6-3 Consultation Summary. AEMO's Procedure changes for STTM and Retail is expected to be completed by 3 March 2025.



3 AER Update on Gas Transparency Measures – Robert Matton, AER

Robert Matton (AER) spoke to the following:

- The AER's gas surveillance oversight
- Observations on reporting completeness, consistency, omissions/errors and published data for:
 - > Short Term Transaction Reporting; and
 - > Reserves and Resources Reporting.
- Overview of other Gas Market Transparency requirements including short term transaction reporting and Gas Bulletin Board reporting that extends to LNG shipment information (new) and extended gas storage reporting.

No questions were received for this item.

4 AEMC Update – Meredith Mayes, AEMC

There was no AEMC update given at this meeting.

5 Gas Market Update – Darryl White, AEMO

Darryl White (AEMO) spoke to the following:

- Gas prices in winter 2023
- LNG export volumes
- Longford supply levels
- Iona storage inventory levels
- Day Ahead Auction usage
- Gas Supply Hub traded volumes

A question was received as follows:

- Jennifer Brownie (Queensland Electricity Users Association) asked if there was any public data on the average residential retail gas prices in Victoria i.e. there has been massive decreases in wholesale gas prices but was the decreased consumption a function of warm temperatures or high retail gas prices for residential customers?
 - Darryl White (AEMO) responded that AEMO doesn't have a specific answer to the query.
 - Luke Stevens (AEMO) noted that AEMO would take this question on notice as an action item.

Note: Analysis on average residential retail gas prices in Victoria is outside of AEMO's role and function as DWGM market operator and DTS operator. Retail gas prices incorporate Transmission Use of System charges, Distribution Use of System charges, wholesale gas market prices (or gas supply agreement costs) and a retail margin. AEMO can only comment on the wholesale gas market price. However, we note that the AER is required under the Retail Law to publish retailers' standing offer plan prices on their website.



6 Other Business

6.1 Gas Market Parameters Review – east coast gas markets – Review of options to improve price caps (Libby Chen (AEMO))

Libby Chen (AEMO) spoke to the paper provided as part of the meeting pack. Feedback is sought from participants by 23 October 2023 to provide input on how to proceed with the work and feedback on the options explored in the paper to address allocative inefficiencies in the east coast gas market.

A question was received as follows:

- Hugh Ridgeway (Alinta) asked if AEMO will be uploading the paper Review of options to improve price caps in the east coast gas markets – onto the consultation page, noting that some people might not pick this up from the notes or if they're not in attendance with the GWCF. What process were AEMO going to go through as next steps?
 - Luke Stevens (AEMO) responded that AEMO are in the pre-consultation phase with this issue so are not looking to put anything on the consultation website. This is just an opportunity for gathering participant views to see if there is broad based industry support for any changes.
 - Hugh Ridgeway (Alinta) followed up with another question on whether AEMO has any idea of what threshold of feedback from the forum is required for this issue to proceed?
 - Luke Stevens (AEMO) responded that AEMO would need wide-ranging support from market participants to proceed with the options.

6.2 STTM Market Operator Service (MOS) (David Younger (AEMO))

David Younger (AEMO) spoke to the following:

- MOS Overview
- Important notification that AEMO will not correct MOS offers after the MOS submission cut-off time and that invalid MOS offers will be removed from the MOS stack.
- How STTM Pipeline Operators can submit correct MOS offers following the SWEX User Guide.

No questions were received for this item.

6.3 Other items (ALL)

Luke Stevens (AEMO) provided a summary of relevant gas consultations including the east coast gas reforms, the National Energy Laws Amendment (Other Gases) Bill 2022, the Hydrogen rule change and DWGM Distribution connected facilities, the Hydrogen rule change for STTM, Retail Market Procedures (NSW/ACT, QLD, SA), GBB, GSOO, and the compensation and dispute resolution frameworks consultation led by the AEMC.

The GWCF accepted the April 2023 meeting notes. No actions were received prior to Meeting 40.

Luke Stevens (AEMO) noted the GWCF webpage will be updated shortly, including the updated meeting pack. Note: The meeting pack has been emailed to participants and uploaded to <u>AEMO's website</u>.

The next GWCF meeting date will be 6 December 2023.
