### 1. Welcome (R. Guest, slides 1-5)

Attendees were welcomed to the WDR CG meeting. AEMO noted that the meeting was being recorded for the purposes of preparing meeting notes.

#### 2. Notes, actions and feedback from previous meeting (G. Ruthven, slides 6 - 7)

The draft meeting notes from WDR CG meeting #4 were endorsed by the WDR CG and will be published as final on the AEMO website.

AEMO provided consolidated responses to the actions arising from WDR CG #4. All actions were closed.

There were no questions or comments from the WDR CG on this agenda item.

#### 3. Consultation updates (M. Hindsberger, M. Bibby and B. Choi, slides 8-11)

AEMO presented updates on 'in-progress' procedures consultations. WDR changes are being consulted on for:

- Demand-side participation information guidelines
- Retail procedures
- Market and system operations procedures

There were no questions or comments from the WDR CG on this agenda item.

## 4. Debrief: 5MS/WDR concurrent implementation (R. Guest, slides 12-21)

AEMO provided a summary of the joint 5MS/WDR forum discussion about concurrent implementation held on Thursday, 1 October 2020. It also asked WDR CG members to please provide feedback if there are any concerns or identified gaps.

Viotas queried whether participants will be able to put a customer profile through AEMO's systems to establish baseline metrics in the event they are unable to build their own capability.



AEMO's portfolio management system is intended to have this functionality, however accessing it is dependent on the participant having the customer's consent to do so.

AEMO noted that it is also intending to provide a spreadsheet calculator on its website. Participants will be able to input metering data and receive baseline accuracy and bias scores for that data.

In relation to AEMO's proposed WDR implementation, Origin consider there is benefit in creating an accelerated workstream supporting current participants to remain compliant if possible. However, acknowledge this may not be practical/achievable from AEMO's perspective if procedures and system changes are already being fast tracked.

Nyrstar asked what the main risks are with the 5MS and WDR implementation schedules and whether the schedules have been stress tested.

**ACTION 05.04.01:** WDR CG to provide feedback on the proposed concurrent implementation of 5MS and WDR, particularly where there are any concerns or identified gaps.

**ACTION 05.04.02:** AEMO to follow up on the extent to which the 5MS/WDR schedules have been stress tested.

### 5. Update: WDR Guidelines and TWG debrief (G. Ruthven, slides 22-25)

AEMO provided a progress update on the development of the WDR Guidelines and a debrief on the WDR Guidelines Technical Working Group, which was held on Monday, 12 October. It noted the increase in participants at the TWG from the first meeting and thanked participants for the 6+hours of valuable discussions that have been held.

There were no questions or comments from the WDR CG on this agenda item.

**ACTION 05.05.01**: WDR CG to suggest any other topics or issues for discussion at the next TWG to inform their submissions to the Issues Paper.

**ACTION 05.05.02**: AEMO to confirm the date of the next TWG (mid-November)

### 6. Stakeholder engagement and forward meeting plan (R. Guest, slides 26-30)

AEMO presented a draft agenda for the next WDR CG meeting and proposed meeting dates and content for 2021.

An attendee enquired whether an approach to industry testing will be presented soon. AEMO has committed to presenting its approach to industry testing in the November WDR CG meeting (slide 28).

AGL asked about when the WDR CG could have more information (process and timelines) on post-event dispatch compliance. AEMO will present its latest thinking at the next meeting.

**ACTION 05.06.01:** WDR CG to provide any further other factors/issues that should be considered for planning the WDR CG 2021 meetings.

**ACTION 05.06.02:** AEMO to present on industry testing and post-event dispatch compliance at the November WDR CG meeting.
